The Mammy Yoko Hotel – Freetown, Sierra Leone

The Mammy Yoko Hotel in the capital city of Freetown (re-branded as the Mammy Yoko Radisson Blu) is a 172-key multi-storey establishment, which was abandoned during the Sierra Leone civil war, first occupied by rebel soldiers and then reoccupied by the United Nations.

Empowering local contractors through on-site training, supervision and guidance

Lategan says that as Sierra Leone has no main contractors available who could have been slotted underneath the project on an organisational level, they had to adopt a methodology that proved highly effective in managing site activities and achieving project milestones. As potential main contractors had little or no experience in hotel refurbishment, construction management issues were overcome by employing a multitude of various artisans who ensured that the construction works were implemented. With increased supervision and quality control measures in place, excellent standards of quality and workmanship were achieved. *Integrated Solutions* provided the correct training, supervision and guidance throughout the duration of the project.

Bridging the language gap and shoring up performance

"Even language barriers were overcome by site staff learning the basics of the local dialect and making use of local translators when necessary. Local workers, used to slow paced construction, proved their worth by the introduction of incentives. The

lack of local technical know-how was overcome by introducing expatriate consultants," says Lategan.

Building partnerships with suppliers on the ground

"In order to create as many local jobs as possible, local general workers were employed, also allowing for skills transfer," said Lategan. Critical to the project success was forging the right relationships amongst all the major local suppliers. Such partnerships proved crucial in securing the right materials and labour that could meet the stringent project standards.

"Additional stock required was offset by site management making use of all redundant materials on site and remaking this to create the necessary items. For the duration of the project, *Integrated Solutions* adopted regulations in line with South African and British standards to ensure that installation would comply with all safety and minimum requirements. Although *Integrated Solutions* had to overcome these major challenges, we're proud that we were able to successfully complete and handover a four star establishment of an international standard," says Lategan.

Integrated Solutions' local footprint in South Africa

In South Africa, *Integrated Solutions* (who specialise in the refurbishment of hotels) also recently completed the upgrade and refurbishment of the Beacon Island Lifestyle Resort in Plettenberg Bay and the Cabana Beach Resort in Umhlanga (on the KwaZulu-Natal North Coast).

A fast track approach for the refurbishments was successfully implemented for these two landmark hotel projects - a first for South Africa where project management, construction management and cost control were spearheaded by *Integrated Solutions*.

The Beacon Island Lifestyle Resort project incorporated a complete shutdown of the complex over an 11-week period. The refurbishment included 200 rooms, as well as the upgrade of all public areas, electrical and plumbing infrastructure, as well as the replacement of all windows. Even a paraplegic facility was added. The full project was completed in 77 days, with a 100% occupancy rate on the day of completion.

The Cabana Beach Resort upgrade entailed the gutting and makeover of 217 apartments that incorporated 441 bathrooms. The schedule of work included electrical, plumbing, air-conditioning, new ceilings, carpets and the skimming of walls. The entire refurbishment was completed in 84 days. Both of these projects were completed on time, on budget and with the necessary attention to detail to maintain the high standards expected by the client (Tsogo Group).
